Resources:

- Sunscreen song (video clip/CD)
- Beach animation
- Beach story book

Link to EYLF outcome/s:

- 2. Children are connected and contribute to their world

- 4. Children are confident and involved learners
- 5. Children are effective communicators

Teaching points:

- Use one or all of the resources to suit the discussion
- Keep on track using guided questioning about the topic

Monitoring:

 Observe participation and understanding of discussion and safety message

Extension:

 Problem Solving -Ask student/s to explain what would happen to Boo if he put sunscreen on his face only

 Collage – Make a collage of a pool students may visit, have at home, or from the book.

Resources:

Teaching points:

Ensure students incorporate safety elements from the story into their work

Monitoring:

- Collect and display work
- Collate work samples for student portfolio

Extension:

- Incorporate multiple safety elements into the collage
- Tell a story about the collage to the class/group

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Activity:

Play-dough modelling – children build one of the home dangers in the story

Resources:

- Home story book
- Play-dough

Teaching points:

- Discuss the safe swimming areas at the beach in relation to your location
- Reading signs is important

Monitoring:

- Participation and play based assessment.
- Pictures of sandpit constructions to collate for student portfolio.

Extension:

 Discuss safe swimming areas of other regions and how they might look different. (E.g. NT or far north QLD)


