


Long, long, ago among the bright stars


Lived a family of aliens quite close to Mars.

And, ever so slowly, opened the door.




Boo jumped out before them with hands in the air,

Wise Owl supervised and without hesitation Immediately started resuscitation.


The alien recovered, shaken and pale

Fence the pool


Shut the gate

I'm having such fun, I've decided to stay."




What an adventure! Boo was so proud.

Home, beach or farm could be our next session."










- 1. Colour photocopy this page.
